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The following was discussed at the RCMP Intelligence meeting this morning:

The PM will be meeting with the Band Council of Chiefs on Friday, January 11th. The PM is not meeting with "Idle No More" reps as has been publically portrayed.

There will be a march from Victoria Island to Parliament Hill on January 11th. Protests are to beginning gathering at Victoria Island around 0700 hours and arrive on the Hill between 10:30 - 10:45 hours. About 1200 have signed up to attend the protest on Facebook. The Demo unit advised that this usually means less then 1/3 will actually show up. "Idle No More" is not known for violence and they are not anticipating problems.

Possibility of Aboriginal Demonstrations or Blockades in Summer 2013

Key Judgments

- Transport Canada has no information suggesting that Aboriginal demonstrations or blockades against the Canadian transportation sector will escalate. (U-FOUO)
- Demonstrations and railroad blockages will likely occur at random times throughout the summer and fall months. (U-FOUO)
- Misperceptions, ongoing frustrations and unfulfilled expectations can inflame minor local issues, causing them to escalate across provinces or nationally. (U-FOUO)
- Almost all Aboriginal demonstrations affecting transportation involve surface transportation (e.g. rail, roads, bridges), not marine or aviation. (U-FOUO)

Introduction

1. Last fall and winter 2012-13 a wave of Aboriginal marches, blockades and protests swept the country, disrupting and interfering with transportation infrastructure. Bridges, rail lines and roads were all adversely affected – some only minimally, while others to a much greater extent. A rail or road blockade can have a domino effect on industries waiting for just-in-time supply chain shipments. No aviation or marine facilities were directly impacted. (U-FOUO)

2. Aboriginal groups have traditionally used summer months to demonstrate and draw attention to a wide range of interests and concerns. At this time there is no indication that widespread, coordinated demonstrations and/or blockades will occur. (U-FOUO)

Background

3. Last winter (2012-13) a new grassroots Aboriginal activist movement called Idle No More (INM) successfully conducted widespread demonstrations using non-violent means.¹ Some demonstrations affected transportation infrastructure including bridges, rail and road service. Other individuals and groups used these demonstrations to either launch their own demonstrations and protests, or join INM demonstrations. (U)
4. In March 2013, Idle No More released a statement calling for "high-profile struggles to defend their land rights" and called for a "Sovereignty Summer." (U)
5. In May 2013 the INM website sought to broaden the demonstration base by inviting non-Aboriginals "to join indigenous communities in coordinating non-violent direct actions in the summer. Alternatives will only come to life if we escalate our actions, taking bold non-violent direct action...." if these demonstrations occur, some may result in transportation blockades. (U)
6. To date, most Aboriginal demonstrations have been legal, and responsibly organized and carried out.² In many cases police were informed beforehand where and when demonstrations would take place. However, in some cases individuals or groups appeared to co-opt Aboriginal and Idle No More demonstrations, causing blockades to rail lines, bridges and highways. (U-FOUO)
7. Historically, a range of issues have sparked protests and blockades, including: (U-FOUO)
- Unresolved land-related grievances
 - Perceived failure to consult and accommodate Aboriginal communities
- Idle No More organizers called for "non-violent direct action to promote Aboriginal rights and environmental protection in alliance with non-native supporters." From Idle No More official website, May 17, 2013.
- ² INM's official website states: "Idle No More feels that any acts that are not in line with peace and solidarity only detract attention from our ultimate mission."

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- Environmental concerns and natural resource development (e.g. mining, fracturing/fracking, pipelines)
 - Perceived failure to respect Aboriginal and treaty rights
 - Unpopular Supreme Court decisions. (U-FOUO)
8. Misperceptions, ongoing frustrations and unfulfilled expectations can enflame minor local issues, causing them to escalate unexpectedly across provinces or the country. Spontaneous demonstrations that reflect local issues could provide a catalyst that causes rapidly expanding demonstrations actions that may affect transportation. (U-FOUO)

Transportation Implications

9. It is hard to estimate the overall economic impact of a rail or road blockade. Depending on circumstances, the financial loss of a full blockade on a main freight rail line for several hours could range widely in dollar figures. Deciding factors include everything from length of time of the blockade, number of railway police needed for security duties, and possible damage to tracks/infrastructure, to the cost of re-routing trains, lawsuits due to missed contracts and loss of perishable goods. Even a partial rail blockade where a train is forced to slow down to safeguard protesters, can have an unpredictable economic domino effect resulting in products not reaching assembly lines dependent on just-in-time delivery. Or a ship might have to wait in port for its cargo to arrive, resulting in additional port and operating fees. A number of international bridges were forced to close temporarily last winter/spring due to marches or blockades, included the Seaway International Bridge, Fort Frances International Falls Bridge, Peace Bridge, Blue Water Bridge and others. (U-FOUO)
10. It is almost impossible to predict the level and scope of Aboriginal protests this summer and fall, partly because of the grassroots nature of it. Even Aboriginal organizers may not be able to predict accurately. However, probably demonstrations will involve a combination of large and small protests and blockades, focused locally and nationally. Almost certainly, some will involve blockading rail and other transportation infrastructure. (U-FOUO)
11. Past Aboriginal demonstrations affecting transportation have focused almost exclusively on surface infrastructure (e.g. rail lines and roads) largely because surface transportation networks often run through (or near) reserves. Although these blockages can have a multi-modal domino effect on ports and airports, in recent years no demonstrations have appeared to specifically target them. (U-FOUO)
