First Nation Demonstration at 5 CDSB Gagetown

Background. At approx 121520L Sept 13 a group of 9 First Nation (FN) people from NB area, led by a self proclaimed Warrior Lt Pictou and Chief _____ marched into the 5 CDSG building heading towards the BComd office area to request an audience IOT negotiate issues. It was explained to them that the CAF were not the proper federal department to negotiate with FN and that they should contact the RCMP.

The group peacefully left the 5 CDSG headquarter building and relocated in front of building H-17 (MP and JAG) peacefully requesting to negotiate land issues.

DComd 5 CDSG, MP, JAG were quickly on site and MP further explained that DND had no authority in this regard and they should contact Oromocto RCMP Det Comd Sgt Saule. Appropriate RCMP contacted for SA.

At approx 121552L Sept 13 5 CDSG G3 contacted Mr Stuart Gilby, representative of the Council of the First Nations Chiefs of NB and he was informed that Chief _____ NB regional rep for the Council, happened to be in Fredericton and would like to help resolving the situation.

DComd contacted _____ at 121557L Sep and during discussion was informed that this group was not representing FN and had no authority to represent on behalf of FN as Warrior Chief _____ is not an elected Chief. _____ informed DComd that both Pictou and _____ are from _____

Group departed H-17 1646 hrs peacefully and left Base proper. They left 'not happy' indicating that they may go to the media as they feel that their Treaty is not being respected and would like that MP intervene if confrontation with RCMP materializes. It was reiterated that we can do nothing and that they need to address concerns with OGDs and/or RCMP. With that said, they requested dialogue with senior CoC Base GTown - no CoC names/#s provided but their contact info taken to 'pass on' to the snr mil CoC.

Situation:

1. At approx 1225 hrs, 3 MP PI Duty Staff recv a telephone call from District and Head Negotiator (To The War Chief to 36 who stated the following:
 - A. SWN Drilling Company has been hired by the Harper Government to work on the First Nations(FN) land. FN has refused to allow this company to continue any work on their land and has forced this company to stop all production;
 - B. Approx 200 RCMP member are currently located at Big Cove, Salmon River First Nation. All negotiations are at a stand still as the FN mbrs refuses to speak with RCMP;
 - C. Claims have been made that RCMP have arrested and assaulted approx 30 First Nations women yesterday. As a direct result, FN are no longer willing to negotiate with the RCMP;
 - D. FN mbrs are enroute to stand-off with RCMP (would not (confirm numbers); however, indications are that FN will match the numbers of the RCMP and will not hesitate to challenge the RCMP;
 - E. Furthermore stated that FN have the right to bear arms and protect their land at "any cost" but do not wish violence to occur; however believes that if the Military does not provide a negotiator to intervene, he foresee a major conflict occurring sometime the afternoon of 28 Jul 13 (DTG of this SITREP);
 - F. stated that according to the 1752 Treaty, it states that if negotiation measures fail with federal government, FN has the right to request that the British or Canadian Military provide a negotiator; and
 - G. has attempted to speak with the District RCMP; however has been unsuccessful thus far.

Ian,

This afternoon at 1406 hrs I received an e-mail from Ops svc branch Ops O to call him back

ASAP. I called him few minutes later and learned that a group of member appearing to be from the First Nation (FN) were at the HQ and were trying to contact Capt Dupuis from MP. The Ops O referred them to Bldg H-17, they took three POMV and crossed over the soccer field and parked in front of the MP Bldg.

At the same time, the shift IC and the DJAG were at my office requesting that I attend the entrance of the MP Bldg because a group of approx 10 person were there and requesting to speak with Capt Dupuis.

I went outside and introduced myself to the group and asked who was in charge. Two male came forward, the first was presenting himself as the spoke person for the group and the second one as the Warrior Chief. I asked them to follow me inside so we can discuss, the Shift IC, myself and the two male went to the soft interrogation room. I asked them what brought them on Base and they started to explain to me that a situation occurred last June between their group and the RCMP during a protest. They alleged that members of RCMP were intimidating them and were perpetrating act of violence towards them. They then explained the context of the event that occurred last June (GO 17620 refers) and they mentioned that they spoke with Capt Dupuis on 28 Jul 13, they seemed satisfied with what happened at the time. They further stated they are expecting another protest and possible riot to occur as they feared the situation with RCMP would escalate. At that time I asked them to be more specific about their expectations towards the MP and they explained that they would like MP or the CAF to negotiate with RCMP and protect them. I then excused myself to make some phone calls.

OC 3 MP Regt Det Gaagetown, BCOMD, PAO, RCMP were briefed. At 1510 I briefed the Dcomd in the AJAG office.

During that time, the shift IC requested to have a written statement from the two representatives of the group.

At approx 1552hrs 5 CDSG G3 contacted the representative of the Council of the First Nations Chiefs of NB and he was informed that NB regional rep for the Council, happened to be in Fredericton and would like to help resolving the situation.

DComd contacted at 1557 hrs and during discussion was informed that this group was not representing FN and had no authority to represent on behalf of FN as the Warrior Chief is not an elected Chief. informed DComd that both representatives of the group are from

At approx 1630 hrs, I informed the two representatives of the group that I consulted with my CoC and there was nothing I could do more to help them. I provide the contact of RCMP det Cmdr in Oromocto and mentioned they have to inform him of their complaint. The group departed H-17 at 1646 hrs peacefully and left Base proper. They left 'not happy' indicating that they may go to the media as they feel that their Treaty is not being respected and would like that MP intervene if confrontation with RCMP materializes. It was reiterated that we can do nothing and that they need to address concerns with OGDs and/or RCMP. With that said, they requested dialogue with senior CoC Base GTown - no CoC names/#s provided but their contact info taken to 'pass on' to the snr mil CoC.

 - b. alleged that RCMP arrested and assaulted approx 30 FN women yesterday. As a direct result, FN are no longer willing to negotiate with the RCMP;
 - c. approx 200 RCMP members are currently located at Salmon River Road First Nations. All negotiations are at a stand still as the FN mbrs refused to speak with RCMP;
 - d. additional FN mbrs are on route to Big Cove First Nations to provide manpower. would not provide confirmation regarding how many mbrs, however he did indicate that he will match the numbers of the RCMP and the FN will not hesitate to challenge them;
 - e. furthermore, he stated that the FN have the right to bear arms and protect their land at "any cost". He does not wish violence to occur, however he believes that if the Military does not provide a negotiator to intervene, he foresees a major conflict occurring sometime this afternoon;
 - f. according to the 1752 Treaty, it states that if negotiation measures fail with Federal Government, FN have the right to request the British or Canadian Military provide a negotiator; and
 - g. he has attempted to speak with the District RCMP Capt however has been unsuccessful thus far.

1. At 1235 hrs, 28 Jul 13,
telephoned 3 MP Regt Det Gagetown and spoke with MCpl MACLEOD.
advised MP that First Nation (FN) members were currently protesting at the Salmon River Road First Nations to halt seismic testing at a proposed shale gas project conducted by SWN Resources Canada company. The FN mbrs refuse to allow SWN to continue any work on their land and have forced this company to stop all production. As a direct result, alleged that the RCMP have created several issues, including assaulting and arresting numerous FN mbrs, therefore FN mbrs are no longer willing to cooperate with RCMP. requested the CAF provide a negotiator to liaise between the FN mbrs and the RCMP. He further stated that according to the 1752 Treaty, if negotiation measures fail with the Federal Government, FN have the right to request the British or Canadian Military provide a negotiator.

2. stated that approx 200 RCMP members are currently located at Salmon River Road First Nations and FN mbrs are on route to Big Cove First Nations to provide manpower, including protecting their land at "any cost". He further stated that he will match the numbers of the RCMP on ground with additional FN members and would not hesitate to challenge them. MP advised she would contact her CoC with his request.

3. MCpl MACLEOD contacted 3 MP Regt Det CoC who were informed of the situation. Capt DUPUIS, OC 3 MP Regt Det Gagetown, commenced communication with from this point on and the matter was referred to the local RCMP, which at the time was deemed acceptable by and there was no further involvement by Military Police.

4. At 1405 hrs, 12 Sep 13, approx eight First Nations members attended 3 MP Regt Det Gagetown to again request the CAF provide a negotiator, as issues between the FN and RCMP have not been resolved. Prior to their arrival at the MP Det, it was learned that they had initially attended bldg D-17, 5 CDSB Headquarters, in search of the MP Det.

5. MCpl MACLEOD, along with Capt THERRIEN, escorted two male FN mbrs and one female FN mbr, later identified as Mr PICTOU, Warrior Chief and Mrs Suzanne PATLES, the Secretary (all mbrs of the Mi'kmaq Warrior Society) to interview room 111 where the following information was obtained:

a. the Mi'kmaq mbrs have been staging demonstrations to protect their land against the SWN Company who are attempting to conduct fracking operations that the FN mbrs feel will cause irreparable environmental damage to their

community and the surrounding area's;

b. the FN mbrs alleged RCMP mbrs have intimidated and committed act of violence towards the protesters and have violated the Treaty Rights of the Mi'kmaq Nation during the native blockade and protest; and

c. the FN mbrs are expecting another protest and possible riots to occur and fear the situation with RCMP will continue to escalate due to the injustice they feel and the alleged act of excessive force used by RCMP. Mr PICTOU stated he believes if the CAF does not provide a negotiator, FN will bare arms to protect their land and rights.

6. Capt THERRIEN contacted and informed the 3 MP Regt Det CoC, BComd, PAO and RCMP of the information learned thus far. Furthermore, Chief

Regional DB for the Council, was contacted and advised. He informed MP that these FN mbrs did not have the authority to represent the FN as Warrior Chief is not an elected Chief.

7. At 1630 hrs, 12 Sep 13, Capt THERRIEN spoke with FN mbrs and advised them that she had consulted with the MP CoC regarding this matter and confirmed that the CAF would not be providing assistance at this time. Furthermore, she provided the contact info for the RCMP Det Commander in Oromocto to file their complaint regarding their allegations.

8. Mrs PATLES and Mr PICTOU expressed their disappointment and discontent, claiming they may go to the media with their concerns as they feel that their Treaty is not being respected; and

9. With no additional information, or change in the matter, FN mbrs departed 3 MP Regt Det without incident.

Note, it was later learned that these FN member's drove in 3 separate vehicles (veh), however only 2 vehs were observed).

2. MCpl MACLEOD informed Capt THERRIEN and Maj HALPIN of the current situation and requested they attend the entrance of the Det. The following occurred:

a. Capt THERRIEN approached the members outside and introduced herself to the group and asked who was in charge. Two males came forward, (later identified as Mr PICTOU, spokes person for the group, and Warrior Chief,

b. Capt THERRIEN requested they speak with her inside the Det, at which time MCpl MACLEOD escorted all parties to the soft interview room, 111;

c. Capt THERRIEN asked what the situation was that brought them on Base. Mr PICTOU stated that Mi'kmaq mbrs have been staging demonstrations to protect against the SWN Company who are attempting to conduct fracking operations that will cause irreparable environmental damage to their community and the surrounding area's. He further stated that several criminal offences have occurred between their group of First Nations Mbrs and the RCMP during the protest, where RCMP mbrs have been intimidating and committing acts of violence towards the protesters;

d. stated that on 28 Jul 13, he spoke with Capt DUPUIS regarding the request to have the CAF provide a negotiator as they were no longer willing to speak with RCMP. After Capt DUPUIS spoke with RCMP, FN Mbrs seemed satisfied with what happened at the time. Post this conversation, FN mbrs used a cell phone application that transmits radio frequency, at which time heard an RCMP transmit "that they declared war" on the FN mbrs; and

e. Mr PICTOU further stated that they are expecting another protest and possible riots to occur as they feared the situation with RCMP have escalated due to the injustice they feel and the alleged act of excessive force used by RCMP. He believes that if the CAF does not provide a

8. At 1557 hrs, 12 Sep 13, MP contacted _____ who advised that this group was not representing FN and had no authority to represent on behalf of FN as the Warrior Chief is not an elected Chief. _____ stated that both representatives of the group are from _____

9. At 1630 hrs, 12 Sep 13, Capt THERRIEN spoke with the representatives of the group and advised them of the following:

- a. she had consulted with the MP CoC regarding this matter;
- b. further she advised them that no assistance could be provided at this time;
- c. she provided the contact number for the RCMP Det Cmdr in Oromocto and advised them to make a report to the RCMP;
- d. Mr PATLES and Mr PICTOU expressed that they were "'not happy'" and indicated that they may go to the media as they feel that their Treaty is not being respected; and
